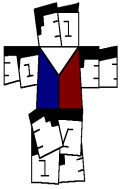


1. Goal, Structure, Membership

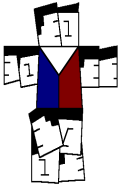
Mission: Mentor and empower strategic public servants to advance righteousness, peace and joy.

Vision: God-loving people united in advancing a righteous and transformative government.

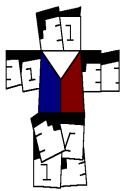




■ a faith-based NGO since October 1989 with a network of 45+ Christian agency groups and government officials from various government agencies in Metro Manila.

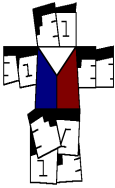
